

Health Policy

In an effort to control the spread of illness and maintain a healthy school environment, **children who exhibit the following conditions are** *not* **to be brought to school:**

- Fever (temperature 100.4° or greater), diarrhea, or vomiting anytime within the past 24 hours
- Listless, tired, or unable to participate in normal daily activities
- Runny nose with thick yellow or green discharge
- Frequent or heavy coughing
- Wheezing or severe sneezing
- Skin rash
- Sore throat, headache, or other symptoms that hinder a student from learning
- **Contagious diseases or conditions such as:

Chicken Pox	Measles
Conjunctivitis (Pink Eye)	Meningitis
Covid-19	Mumps
Hand, Foot & Mouth Disease (HFMD)	Pinworms
Head Lice	Ringworm
Impetigo	Staph infection
Influenza A or B	Streptococcus (Strep Throat)

** If your child is diagnosed with any of these illnesses, please notify the main office at (561) 686-8081 immediately.

Your child may return to school when:

- Temperature remains normal for **24 hours** without the aid of a fever-reducing medication and without any other signs and symptoms of illness.
- Diarrhea or vomiting has ceased for **24 hours**.
- The rash has been evaluated by a physician and the nature of the rash has been determined. A physician's note will be required for the student to re-enter school.
- He or she has been on antibiotics for **24 hours** and the doctor signs a re-admittance-to-school statement, or an email or fax from the doctor's office has been received by the School Nurse (nurse@atlanticca.com).

If your child becomes ill or displays any of the above symptoms while at school, we will contact you to pick up your child immediately. *Additional measures may be taken in regards to Covid 19* and will be communicated to the parent or guardian by the school nurse.
