Elementary Chapel This week in chapel, we recognized students who exhibit the fruit of the Spirit *goodness*. We are so proud of our Wisdom Kids! We heard a great message from Luis Gonzalez from Christ Fellowship Español. He spoke to us about Joshua and the wall of Jericho. He had students come forward to act out the story of the walls crumbling down! He reminded us of three important truths. First, their faith in God's power allowed them to march with confidence. Second, we should remember to celebrate and enjoy what the Lord is doing. Finally, it is important to remember what the Lord has done. He still has the power to do great things today, which gives us encouragement to be faithful and obedient to his commands.

During today's middle and high school chapel's our students were encouraged to foster three kids of relationships:

- 1. a mentor (one to **look up** to)
- 2. an *in the trenches* friend (one to **look over** at)
