Are you ready for a new and refreshing approach to engage in summer reading?



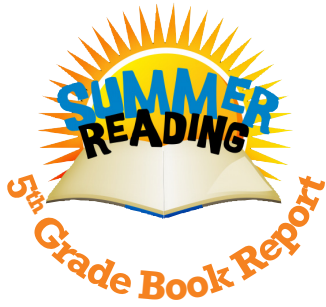
