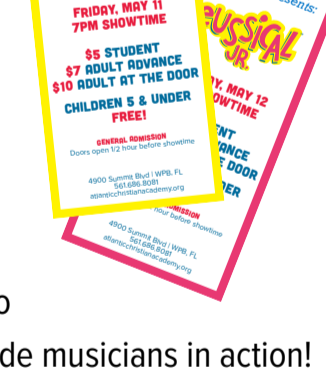

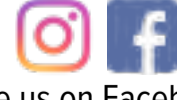
ATHLETICS
